Council approval will provide for the continuation of the existing CDBG youth services program provided by AUSTIN TRAVIS COUNTY INTEGRAL CARE for the initial term of October 1, 2016 - September 30, 2017.

The CDBG youth services program provides eligible services for youth and families through the Youth and Family Assessment Center (YFAC). These services include education, training, assessment/evaluation, counseling/therapy, community supports (i.e. respite care, childcare, employment services, etc.) and enrichment services (after school programs, educational camps, etc.). Austin Travis County Integral Care will provide fiscal oversight and quality assurance for the youth and family services network established under this agreement.

NHCD hereby designates Austin Travis County Integral Care as a subrecipient for the CDBG Youth Services Program contract for fiscal year 2016-17 based upon their experience for more than 15 years.
