<p>In accordance with the City of Austin Coyote Management Policy, should the Austin Animal Services Office have a need for technical assistance and response to a coyote public safety issue the interlocal agreement will provide for a collaborative response to a public safety situation. A separate agreement, unrelated to the interlocal agreement with Travis County, with the Texas A&amp;M Agrilife Extension - Wildlife Services will provide collaborative resolutions per the City's Coyote Management Policy and Coyote Response Guide.</p> <p>If approved by Council, the agreement would be for one year with four additional 12 month options. Services will be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per year.</p>
