PROPOSAL

Relocate a ca. 1956 house to outside the city.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with an off-set, partial-width, front-gabled independent porch on plain, square wood posts; single and paired 1:1 fenestration.

RESEARCH

The house was built during the winter of 1956-1957 by Fabian Garza and his wife, Theresa, who lived here until around 1963. Fabian Garza had no occupation listed in the city directories during the time that he and Theresa lived in this house, but prior city directories show him as a laborer. He also does not appear in any census reports for Austin.

STAFF COMMENTS

The house is not listed in any city survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage rehabilitation and adaptive re-use on-site, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center. The house has neither the architectural nor the historical significance to warrant individual designation as a historic landmark.
