Additional Backup Information

This action will approve the proposed East Sixth Street Public Improvement District (PID) Service and Assessment Plan and Budget update for 2017, as provided to the City by 6ixth Street Austin. State law requires City Council review, update and approval of the Service and Assessment Plan and Budget, which serves as the basis for the proposed assessment roll. The PID assessment will provide services in the following categories: Infrastructure and Physical Environment; Public Safety; Communications and Membership, and; Marketing, Fundraising and Economic Development.

The total projected revenue is \$165,026. This estimate is based on the real property appraisal roll from the Travis Central Appraisal District (TCAD) as of August 11, 2016. Adjustments to the roll may be required based on new information from TCAD and Council action as a result of the December 1, 2016 public hearing. Approval of the proposed PID service and assessment plan and budget update, and the ordinance adopting an assessment rate and proposed assessment roll are the first steps in the annual process of approving PID assessments.
