#### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month contract with JOHN BEAN TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION DBA JBT AEROTECH, JETWAY SYSTEMS, to provide JetAire pre-conditioned air units inspection, maintenance, repair services, and training, in an amount not to exceed \$339,000, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$113,000 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$678,000.

# Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$113,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Operating Budget of Aviation. Funding for the remaining 24 months of the original contract period and extension options are contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

#### Additional Backup Information

The contract provides the inspection, maintenance, repairs, and on-site training for the City's 24 JetAire preconditioned air units at the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA). These air units provide cooling and heating to the aircraft cabins while parked at the airport gates. This contract will provide the necessary support to ensure the air units are maintained according to the original equipment manufacturer specifications.

If a contract is not secured, the airlines would be required to run their auxiliary engine to support the airplane's cooling and heating which increases the airplane's fuel consumption and pollution.
