**PROPOSAL**

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Demolish a ca. 1946 house.

**ARCHITECTURE**

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One-story, side-gabled frame house with single fenestration; synthetic siding.

**RESEARCH**

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The house proposed for demolition is the back house on this lot. Both this and the front house were built in 1946 by W.L. Tipton as rental properties. The tenants of 805-B W. Johanna included an assistant poultry buyer, a proprietor of a used car lot, a truck driver for a concrete contractor, and a saleslady at J.C. Penney at Highland Mall.

**STAFF COMMENTS**

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The house is not listed in any City survey to date.




**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

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Encourage rehabilitation and adaptive re-use, then relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center. The house does not qualify as a historic landmark, but every effort should be made to re-use this unit of affordable housing.

## BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

### **Odis O. and Alberta Anderson (ca. 1946 – ca. 1948)**

Otis O. Anderson appears in the 1940 U.S. Census as the 16-year old son of Preston C. and Lillian Anderson, who rented their home at 808 Patterson Avenue in Austin. Otis had an older brother, Rufus, 21. Otis had been born in Texas and had no occupation listed. His older brother was a truck driver for a wholesale grocery company. His father, Preston, was a salesman for a food company. The family had lived in Mart, Texas in 1935.

### **James and Billie Wimberly (ca. 1957 – ca. 1965) – House “A:**

According to her 1982 death certificate, Billie June Wimberly was born in 1931 in Mexia, Texas. She was a waitress in a restaurant. She and her surviving spouse, James Edward Wimberly, were living in rural Caldwell County, Texas at the time of her death. She is buried in Marble Falls. James Edward Wimberly was born in 1921, and is still alive.

### WIMBERLY, James Edward



93, Born March 31, 1921. He went to be with his Lord and Savior on December 9, 2014. He was affectionately known as "J.E." or "Conway" to his friends.

Was an Ironworker, member Local 482 for over 50 years. He is survived by 10 children: Peggy Humphries, Faye Burling, Margaret Lujan, William Wimberly, Neal Wimberly Sr, Sheila Cook, Kandy Etheredge, James E. Wimberly Jr., Michael Wimberly, Michelle Harmon. He was preceded in death by all of his siblings, a daughter, Patricia Wimberly his wife, Billie Wimberly and grandson, Neal E. Wimberly Jr. He was an avid hunter, fisherman, loved to grow his garden. He was raised around pecan orchards. He loved his family and his dog "Pee Wee". He loved to read, travel, gamble and tell great stories. He had a phenomenal memory; He left a great legacy behind with 24 grandchildren, 35 great grandchildren, and 21 great, great grandchildren. Services held at Angel Funeral Home at 1600 S. 1st St. Austin, Texas at 9:00 am Saturday, December 13, graveside service will be at 12:30 at Marble Falls City Cemetery.

Water service permit to T.N. Griffin for House "B" (1946)

There is a 1982 permit to repair and remodel the residence. In 2008, permits were approved to demolish the detached carport and garage, as well as for the partial demolition of the south rear wall. A new detached carport, a new utility room addition, and new HVAC were also approved in 2008. The irrigation system was installed in 2013. There was a short term rental complaint in January, 2016 and a permit to run a gas line to the stove from the existing gas line in March, 2016.
