PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1953 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, wing-and-gable plan frame house with a partial-width, shed-roofed independent porch; single and paired 1:1 fenestration.

RESEARCH

The house was built in 1953 by local builder Joe Hoffman. The first owners and occupants were Charles H. and Betty J. Rehn, who lived here from around 1953 to around 1957. Charles Rehn was a salesman for Austin Hydro Gas Company, a butane and propane dealer, while he lived in this house. He later went on to be the sales manager for the Lennox Corporation, heating and air conditioning manufacturers and installers.


The house was a rental property in the late 1950s, then owned by an Army man in the early 1960s. From around 1970 until 2010, the house was owned and occupied by Mike and Mary Ellen Rangel. Mike Rangel was a foreman at Guerrero's Carpet Cleaners on S. 1st Street for many years, then went to work for a lawfirm.


STAFF COMMENTS

STAFF RECOMMENDATION



BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Charles H. and Betty J. Rehn (ca. 1953 – ca. 1957)

The 1940 U.S. Census shows Charles Henry Rehn as the 17-year old so of Oscar and Bessie Rehn, who owned their house in Justice Precinct 8 of Williamson County, Texas. Charles had been born in Texas, and had no occupation listed. His father, Oscar Rehn, 53, had been born in Sweden, and was a farmer. His mother, Bessie Rehn, 46, had been born in Texas and had no occupation listed. There were no other children listed in the census report.

His 1968 death certificate shows that Charles Henry Rehn was born in 1922 in Williamson County, Texas, and was living at 3001 Stardust Drive at the time of his death. He was a territorial sales manager for Lennox Industries.

CHARLES REAN

Charles Rehn, 3001 Stardust, died suddenly in a local hospital Friday.

He was a member of the Hyde Park Baptist Church. Mr. Rehn was Territorial Sales Manager for the Lennox Industrial Corporation. He was also a member of Masonic Lodge no. 456 AF&AM.

Mr. Rehn served in the Air

Corps during World War II.


