Authorize award and execution of a 12-month contract with TRAFFIC LOGIX CORP., to provide rubber speed cushions and rubber curbs, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$800,000.					
Amount and Source of Funding					
Funding in the amount of \$333,333 is available in the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Capital Budget of the Transportation Department. Funding for the remaining two months of the original contract period and extension options are contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Purchasing Language:	The Purchasing Office issued an Invitation for Bids (IFB) SLW0118 for these goods on August 22, 2016 and it closed on September 15, 2016 with one offer received. The recommended offer is the sole offer submitted by a responsible offeror. Additional information on the solicitation is included below the line. The recommended offeror is the current provider for these goods.

MBE / WBE:	This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9D Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. For the goods required for this solicitation, there were insufficient subcontracting				

opportunities and an insufficient number of certified M/WBEs; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established.

#### Additional Backup Information

The contract will provide prefabricated rubber speed cushions and flexible rubber curb. This is in response to the high demand of speed mitigation requests received citywide. Pre-fabricated rubber devices have been shown to reduce speeds to a reasonable range, while also being more cost effective than asphalt humps, cushions, or concrete devices. Pre-fabricated rubber cushions will also allow for a more timely installation after a project is identified.

This will be a new contract. The requested authorization amount is based on the current backlog of projects that need to be completed, as well as Quarter Cent Program money received from Capital Metro for transportation improvements.

If the City is unable to secure the contract, the City will be unable to respond to the requests for speed mitigation.
