## Additional Backup Information

If approved, this resolution will be submitted by Austin Habitat for Humanity, Inc. (Habitat) along with its proposal to the Austin Independent School District (AISD) for one of ten parcels AISD has identified as surplus property. AISD has issued a Public Notice of Sale, Exchange, or Lease of Real Property, and is accepting proposals, offers, and bids on the ten parcels. Habitat will be submitting a proposal to develop the vacant land adjacent to the AISD Service Center on East 51<sup>st</sup> Street for affordable ownership housing. (District 1)

If Habitat's proposal is selected, it is anticipated that Habitat would apply to the Austin Housing Finance Corporation for a portion of the development funding.
