As a standard business practice, the City routinely engages the services of professional engineering firms to perform analysis, design, and related support associated with construction or improvement of City capital assets. Rotation list contracting allows the City to always have a group of qualified consultants available to perform a specific type of recurring work in a timely manner to meet the project needs of the City.

Prior to issuing, this solicitation was reviewed by the City's Rotation List Advisory Committee, which is made up of staff from the Capital Contracting Office, Small and Minority Business Resource Department, and Public Works Department. The total authorization amount, the number of firms to be recommended for selection, and the authorization amount per firm were reviewed by the Committee. Numerous upcoming projects have been identified as part of the current Capital Improvement Program. These projects will require external engineering services to properly plan, evaluate, design, and implement current and future engineering customers' needs.

The existing 2014 Structural Engineering rotation list was established utilizing five firms to provide structural engineering services for various departments within the City.

The firms selected for the 2017 Structural Engineering Services will provide the following for various City projects:

- Structural evaluations and condition reports for buildings, parking garages, bridges, pools, dams and plant facilities. Determination of structural adequacy of existing facilities to accommodate additional design loads and updated design standards.
- Design of foundations, retaining walls, small building renovation projects and related construction phase services.
- Assisting in the review of proposed building plans and other structural engineering projects for compliance with City structural standards.
- Providing cost estimates for the design development services in support of the City's Job Order Contracting program.

The total funding authority for the 2017 Structural Engineering Rotation List is \$1,250,000 with the authority for each of the five firms to be approximately \$250,000.

Authority on the existing 2014 Structural Engineering Rotation List will be expended in the near future therefore a delay in establishing the 2017 Structural Engineering Rotation List would negatively impact capital improvement projects throughout the City.

This request allows for the development of a professional services agreement with each of the five recommended firms for an estimated period of three years or until financial authorization is expended. Initial project assignments will be based on the firm's final ranking as determined during the Request for Qualifications evaluation (highest to lowest), the maximum cumulative contracted amount in comparison to the estimated task budget for that firm, and the firm's qualifications and availability of expertise at time of project need. Per firm authorizations may be increased or decreased, through the life of the contract, based on the needs of a particular assignment and will follow the established rotation list policies and procedures. If the City is unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with a recommended firm(s), if a selected firm ceases practice during the contract period, or if the City elects to terminate its agreement with one of the selected firms, the remaining assignments will be assigned to the remaining firm(s) for the duration of the contract period.
