SUBJECT: Approve an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Parks and Recreation Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20160914-001) to accept and appropriate up to $\$ 250,000$ from the Trail of Lights Foundation for payment of City services, and approve the waiver or reimbursement of certain permit, application and similar fees and requirements for the 2016 Trail of Lights in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.

ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The total amount of fees for waived for this event are not to exceed $\$ 200,000$. Additionally, the Austin Transportation Department refundable security deposit requirements of $\$ 2,050$ and the Parks and Recreation Department refundable damage deposit requirements of $\$ 3,500$ are also being waived. Waiving fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the Mobility Fund, Austin Transportation Department, and the General Fund, which includes the Parks and Recreation, Austin Fire and Health and Human Services Departments. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
