Agenda Item: Briefing and discussion with possible action on roadway speed reductions and potential pilot program per Council Resolution No. 20160519-049 that adopted the Vision Zero Action Plan.

Summary of Discussion:

- Erich Bollich, Managing Engineer with the Austin Transportation Department, gave a presentation reviewing the Vision Zero Action Plan vision, the effect of speed on crash outcomes, the benefits of lowering speeds, existing practices for setting speed limits, Emerging Methods to Reduce Posted Speed Limits. The presentation outlined four recommendations:
 - Support legislative efforts to lower the prima facie speed to 25 mph.
 - Incorporate target design speeds into plans & manuals.
 - Systematically evaluate arterial speed limits citywide for appropriateness.
 - Establish a neighborhood slow zone pilot.
- Council Member Kitchen moved to forward staff's recommendations, to the full Council's upcoming meeting on December 15th. Council Member Garza seconded the motion. The motion passed on a 3-1 vote with Council Member Zimmerman opposed.
