CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:38 pm

1. CITIZEN COMMUNICATION: GENERAL

The first ten speakers signed up prior to the meeting being called to order will each be allowed a three-minute allotment to address their concerns regarding items not posted on the agenda.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – September 14, 2016

Minutes from the Commission's regular meeting of September 14, 2016 were approved on Commissioner Vaughn's motions; Commissioner Floyd's second, on a vote of 8-0. (Commissioner Newell and Pruthi excused absence)

3. COMMISSION UPDATES (Discussion and Possible Action)

a. Commission Effectiveness Working Group.

Commissioner Vaughn reported he met with Council Member Troxclair's chief of staff. He stated Council wants the Commission to make recommendations are things Council will be voting on.

Commissioner Vaughn asked, what do you see this commission working on throughout the year?

Chief of Staff stated:

- -What are the primary areas of focus for you and the realm of technology in the city?
- How can we help address the larger issues related to technology? How can we keep track of what those issues are?
- -How can we work with other Commissions on related issues that cover multiple areas of focus?
- How can we ensure that staff brings technology related issues to the commission well before council meets to vote on those issues?

Commissioner Vaughn requested the other Commissioner also meet with their Council Member.

b. Civic Technology Working Group.

Commissioner Yeatts reported that the Neighborhood Planning Group is offering classes to neighborhood groups about how to get information from the City website. He has scheduled a class for his neighborhood and other neighborhoods in Austin have been notified to set up classes.

Commissioner Williams asked that the agenda for these classes be sent to the Commissioners. He also asked for feedback from these classes so the Open Government Working Group can approach CTM with recommendations.

He also contact Grande and AT&T to see if they provided Gigabit service to his area and found that these providers do but they only provide this service in certain areas. He spoke with Sly Majid, Chief Service Officer in the Mayor's office and found this information to be a hot button with the Mayor.

Commission DasGupta will schedule a meeting with Mr. Majid and the working group then work with staff on getting an answer from the providers.

Commissioner Vaughn met with Google Fiber regarding the Community Connections program. His concern is how is Google providing information or support to the connection sites on how they can utilize the connection
