The Contract will be in effect for an initial term of thirty-six (36) months and may be extended thereafter for up to three (3) twelve (12) month extension option(s), subject to the approval of the Contractor and the City Purchasing Officer or his designee. - 1.4 Compensation. The Contractor shall be paid a total Not-to-Exceed amount of \$187,900 for the initial Contract term and \$133,000 for each extension option as indicated in the Bid Sheet, IFB Section 0600. Total Contract amount Not-to-Exceed amount of \$586,900. Payment shall be made upon successful completion of services or delivery of goods as outlined in each individual Delivery Order.
- 1.5 Quantity of Work. There is no guaranteed quantity of work for the period of the Contract and there are no minimum order quantities. Work will be on an as needed basis as specified by the City for each Delivery Order

RMA

Overview

RMAs are created by the Sales Department when a customer needs to return something for Credit, Repair, or Replacement. The RMA is then processed by the RMA Department.

There are four main RMA types that are used:

- Credit: When RMA is received, item(s) will go into inventory and credit will be issued to customer.
- Replace: Same as Credit type. In addition, a Replacement RMAORD will be generated to ship the customer replacement items.
- Cross-Ship: Same as Replace type. Except, that there is the option to generate the Replacement RMAORD prior to the RMA being received. (Note that any items that are not Cross-Shipped prior to the RMA being received will have an RMAORD generated upon receipt, this is typically voided)
- Repair: When RMA is received, item(s) will not go into inventory. No
 credit will be issued. A Process (i.e. Depot Work Order or Repair RTV)
 must be performed before RMA can be closed.

The Accounting Department ensures that the RMA is processed correctly, creating/changing serial numbers as needed, and performs the final closing of the RMA.

New RMA's

Starting August 1st 2012, Department Manager will need to authorize credits over \$5K.

In order for Accounting Department to process and post credits an authorization from the department manager needs to be included in the CRM. Failure to include the authorization will slow down the closing process.

1.0 PURPOSE

This Invitation for Bid (IFB) is to establish the minimum requirements for Adjustable and Expandable Traffic Signal Heads. The bid shall be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. This specification for 12" Aluminum Traffic Signal Heads with tunnel visors contains the minimum applicable specifications, functional requirements, material requirement, and any other requirements.

The traffic signal heads described herein shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the latest revision of The Institute of Image Information and Television Engineers (ITE) Technical Report No. 1, "Adjustable Face Vehicle Traffic Control," Signal Head Standard and the additional requirements contained in this specification. The traffic signal heads in this specification SHALL NOT include lenses, reflectors, light emitting diodes (LED's), or bulbs

2.0 PRODUCT REQUIREMENTS

All neutral wires shall be able to be terminated at two (2) terminal points and the two terminal points shall be connected with a barrier jumper.
- 3.5 The five (5) section signal heads shall be provided with a terminal block mounted in sections two (2) and four (4) of the section signal head assembly in an easily accessible position. It shall be of weatherproof molded construction. The terminal blocks shall be double row and have a minimum of six double row positions with #10 binder head screws. All neutral wires shall be able to be terminated at two (2) terminal points; the two terminal points shall be connected with a barrier jumper.

3.6 All exposed metal surfaces of the housing, door, and the outside surface of all visors shall be given two (2) coats separately baked on of high grade Federal Yellow enamel. Powder coat paint shall be acceptable instead of enamel paint. The inside surfaces of all visors shall be given two (2) coats of high-grade dull black enamel. Colors shall conform to ITE and Federal Highway Administration Color standards.

4.0 OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1 **Visor shall be shipped attached to the signal housing.** Extreme care will be exercised when packaging to ensure that the equipment is not broken or damaged during shipment. The visors and head assembly shall be oriented for horizontal installation with the door hinges at the bottom. The visor shall be attached to the door and be held in place with four (4) screws.
