

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL

CITY OF AUSTIN, TEXAS

Special Meeting

September 11, 1972

5:00 P. M.

COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL

Mayor Butler announced this was a Special Meeting of the City Council called for the purpose of adopting a resolution canvassing returns and declaring results of a City Bond Election. All members of the Council had signed the Consent to Meeting.

Roll Call:

Absent: Councilmen Handcox, Dryden

City Attorney Butler announced the Council had before it copies of the returns of the various precincts. Mr. Norman Barker, Director of Finance; Mr. Ed Rosen, Accounting Supervisor; and Mr. Bill A. Harrison, Auditor, had verified the figures as to the totals and could present testimony to this extent.

Mayor Butler ascertained that Messrs. Barker, Rosen, and Harrison had checked these figures to the best of their ability and they acknowledged the figures were accurate. The City Attorney stated he found the count to be in order.

Fluoridation

Mr. Bill Harrison gave the results of the canvass of returns on the Referendum Proposition - Fluoridation of the public water supply as follows:

Votes	AGAINST	Fluoridation	12,687	29,651

Councilman Lebermann moved the Council adopt the resolution accepting the results of the referendum for fluoridation of the public water supply and directing the City Administration to proceed to initiate the fluoridation of the public water supply; and announcing there would be no more hearings, as this is in line with the Council's previous commitments. The motion, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Love, carried by the following vote:
