PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1954 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, front-gabled frame house on a raised concrete foundation; partial-width, front-gabled, partially inset independent porch on ornamental metal supports; metal-framed fenestration.

RESEARCH


The house dates from the winter of 1953-54; it was vacant for the first few years of its existence, then owned by Augustine and Genoveva Garcia (or Garza), who lived here through the 1980s. Augustine Garza was a farmer and laborer before he retired in the mid-1970s. There is a permit from 1952 that addresses a relocation of a house onto the site, but it does not appear that it was ever executed.


STAFF COMMENTS

The house is listed in the East Austin Historical Survey (2016) with an estimated construction date of 1954. It is not recommended for designation individually nor is it located within a potential historic district.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage rehabilitation and adaptive re-use, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center. The house has neither the architectural nor the historical significance to warrant individual designation as a historic landmark.


