The contract will provide cleaning, televising, and point repair of sanitary sewer collection system pipes throughout the City with the exception of the Downtown Austin Project Coordination Zone. This contact also includes inspection of wastewater manholes, inspection of wastewater service laterals, and smoke testing of the wastewater collection system.

The wastewater collection system includes over 2,800 miles of piping throughout the City that transports wastewater from residences and businesses to the City's wastewater treatment plants. Pipe sizes range from 4 inches to 54 inches in diameter. In accordance with best management practices, existing collection system assets require on-going maintenance and inspection. The maintenance process includes removing sludge, roots, grease, grit, solids, and other debris from the wastewater pipes and adjacent manholes. The inspection process involves televising cleaned sewer mains and coding any defective conditions in the mains for repairs as may be required. Austin Water will use the inspection data collected to prioritize capital improvement projects.

The current contract will expire March 18, 2017; with an average yearly spend of \$1,358,396. If this contract is not secured, the lack of cleaning and inspection will result in inadequate information to properly assess the wastewater system and could allow critical problems in the wastewater system to remain undetected.
