# A. Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) Near Northwest Corridor Study – Discussion and Possible Action

Kelly Porter, Regional Planning Manager with CAMPO, briefed the BAC on CAMPO's <u>2025 Regional Active Transportation Plan</u> as well as the <u>Near Northwest Corridor Study</u>.

**Action taken:** The motion below was approved unanimously (9-0) by the BAC, after debate and amendment, on Tom Wald's motion and Miller Nuttle's second:

We thank CAMPO, CTRMA, TxDOT, Toole Design Group, the cities of Cedar Park and Austin as well as Williamson County, Travis County and Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority for completing the thorough study of bicycle and pedestrian connectivity in the Near Northwest Corridor Connections Case Study.

The study holistically addresses bicycling connectivity in the area by introducing all ages and abilities facilities such as protected bike lanes and shared use path connections. We request shared funding contributions from TxDOT, CTRMA and the City of Austin to complete the spine and rib network, including all ages and abilities facilities wherever possible – to complement the current 183N project. These are regional access improvements and should be funded using regional resources.
