CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AUSTIN ("City") AND Ameriturf ("Contractor") for Golf Course Grounds Maintenance Materials MA 8600 GA160000062

The City accepts the Contractor's Offer (as referenced in Section 1.1.3 below) for the above requirement and enters into the following Contract.

This Contract is between Ameriturf having offices at P.O. Box 194, Italy, TX 76651 and the City, a home-rule municipality incorporated by the State of Texas, and is effective as of May 17, 2016 ("Effective Date").

Capitalized terms used but not defined herein have the meanings given them in Solicitation Number IFB SMB0100.

- 1.2 <u>Order of Precedence</u>. Any inconsistency or conflict in the Contract documents shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:

1.2.1 This document and Exhibit A as referenced in Section 1.1.2

- 1.2.2 The City's Solicitation as referenced in Section 1.1.3, including all documents incorporated by reference
- 1.2.3 The Contractor's Offer as referenced in Section 1.1.4, including subsequent clarifications.
- 1.3 <u>Term of Contract.</u> The Contract will remain in effect for an initial term of 36 months and may be extended thereafter for up to two additional 12-month extension options, subject to the approval of the Contractor and the City Purchasing Officer or his designee. See the Term of Contract provision in Section 0400 for additional Contract requirements.
- 1.4 <u>**Compensation**</u>. Contracts have been awarded to two Contractors with a combined not-toexceed amount of \$948,915 for the initial Contract term and a combined not-to-exceed amount of \$316,305 for each extension option. Payment shall be made upon successful completion of services or delivery of goods as outlined in each individual Delivery Order.
- 1.5 <u>Quantity of Work.</u> There is no guaranteed quantity of work for the period of the Contract, and there are no minimum order quantities. Work will be on an as needed basis as specified by the City for each Delivery Order
- 1.6 **<u>Clarifications and Additional Agreements.</u>** The following are incorporated into the Contract.

- 1.6.1 **Designation of Key Personnel.** The Contractor's Contract Manager for this engagement shall be Cameron McDermid, Phone: (512) 563-3007, Email Address: cmcdermid@austin.rr.com. The City's Contract Manager for the engagement shall be Nick Smitham, Phone: (512) 447-2616, Email Address: Nick.Smitham@austintexas.gov. The City and the Contractor resolve to keep the same key personnel assigned to this engagement throughout its term. In the event that it becomes necessary for the Contractor to replace any key personnel, the replacement will be an individual having equivalent experience and competence in executing projects such as the one described herein. Additionally, the Contractor will promptly notify the City Contract Manager and obtain approval for the replacement. Such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 1.6.2 Line Items Eligible for Purchase. The City may purchase the line items highlighted in yellow in Exhibit A.

This Contract (including any Exhibits) constitutes the entire agreement of the parties regarding the subject matter of this Contract and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements and understandings, whether written or oral, relating to such subject matter. This Contract may be altered, amended, or modified only by a written instrument signed by the duly authorized representatives of both parties.

B. The Contractor agrees to accept payment by either credit card, check or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) for all goods and/or services provided under the Contract. The Contractor shall factor the cost of processing credit card payments into the Offer. There shall be no additional charges, surcharges, or penalties to the City for payments made by credit card.

7. **RESTOCKING FEES**:

- A. The Contractor may bill the City restocking fees (if included in their Offer) for parts that are ordered by the City under the contract and returned for refund. The Contractor is not obligated to accept for refund any part that is not resalable and/or not in the same condition as when purchased.
- B. Restocking fees may be charged to the City when multiple parts or groups of parts are returned for refund at one time due to the City inventory warehouse cleaning, unless these parts are returned at an annual pre-arranged date. The date for the annual return shall be mutually agreed upon between the City and the Contractor.

8. MATERIALS SPECIFICATIONS/DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE:

Upon expiration of the initial term or period of extension, the Contractor agrees to hold over under the terms and conditions of this agreement for such a period of time as is reasonably necessary to re-solicit and/or complete the project (not to exceed 120 days unless mutually agreed on in writing).
- C. Upon written notice to the Contractor from the City's Purchasing Officer or his designee and acceptance of the Contractor, the term of this contract shall be extended on the same terms and conditions for an additional period as indicated in paragraph A above.
- D. Prices are firm and fixed for the first 12 months. Thereafter, price changes are subject to the Economic Price Adjustment provisions of this Contract.
- 4. <u>QUANTITIES</u>: The quantities listed herein are estimates for the period of the Contract. The City reserves the right to purchase more or less of these quantities as may be required during the Contract term. Quantities will be as needed and specified by the City for each order. Unless specified in the solicitation, there are no minimum order quantities.

B. The Contractor agrees to accept payment by either credit card, check or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) for all goods and/or services provided under the Contract. The Contractor shall factor the cost of processing credit card payments into the Offer. There shall be no additional charges, surcharges, or penalties to the City for payments made by credit card.

7. **RESTOCKING FEES**:

- A. The Contractor may bill the City restocking fees (if included in their Offer) for parts that are ordered by the City under the contract and returned for refund. The Contractor is not obligated to accept for refund any part that is not resalable and/or not in the same condition as when purchased.
- B. Restocking fees may be charged to the City when multiple parts or groups of parts are returned for refund at one time due to the City inventory warehouse cleaning, unless these parts are returned at an annual pre-arranged date. The date for the annual return shall be mutually agreed upon between the City and the Contractor.

10. PUBLISHED PRICE LISTS:

11. NON-COLLUSION, NON-CONFLICT OF INTEREST, AND ANTI-LOBBYING:

- A. On November 10, 2011, the Austin City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20111110-052 amending Chapter 2.7, Article 6 of the City Code relating to Anti-Lobbying and Procurement.
