The contract will provide maintenance and support for Bruel & Kjaer's Airport Noise and Operations Monitoring System (ANOMS) 9 currently in place at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA). ANOMS 9 is a complete solution for accurate monitoring and management of noise and operations. ANOMS 9 allows Aviation Department staff to gather information on the movement of aircraft and noise levels at ABIA and surrounding areas to measure the success of noise reduction strategies in surrounding airport communities. Bruel & Kjaer EMS, Inc. is the sole provider for the ANOMS 9 system and is a sole provider for the maintenance and support.

This contract will replace an existing contract with Bruel & Kjaer EMS, Inc. set to expire on May 10, 2017. This contract is needed in order to meet the current Part 150 Noise Compatibility Program at ABIA approved by Federal Aviation Administration on December 7, 2007. One of the approved program management measures is a Noise and Operations Track Monitoring System to allow the airport to continue their implementation and monitoring of the noise abatement program.
