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Memorandum of Understanding Relating to Security Services for the Combined Transportation, Emergency & Communications Center

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This Memorandum of Understanding (this "Agreement") is between the City of Austin (the "City") and Travis County (the "County"), collectively called the "Parties," with individual Parties sometimes referred to as a "Party", to provide certain security and loss prevention services in connection with the operation and maintenance of a cooperative, regional Combined Transportation, Emergency & Communications Center, in the Austin/Travis County area.

WHEREAS, the Parties, in concurrence with the Texas Department of Transportation and the Capital Metropolitan Transit Authority (the other charter coalition members, who together with both Parties are called the "Coalition Members"), have determined that a unified regional emergency communication and transportation management system in the Austin/Travis County area will improve the ability of public safety and public service agencies to cooperate and communicate with each other, and will allow direct access to and exchange of information, thereby promoting the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Parties, through an interlocal cooperative effort involving all four charter Coalition Members, have constructed a building and related site improvements ("Facility") at 5010 Old Manor Road in Austin, Texas (the "Site") to support and house a unified, regional emergency communication and transportation management system in the Austin/Travis County area ("Supported Systems"); and

WHEREAS, the City, acting as the lead Coalition Member and managing partner, is authorized by the Interlocal Agreement for Operations and Maintenance of the Facility and Supported Systems ("CEC Interlocal") to contract and incur costs and expenses on behalf of the Coalition Members in supplying goods and services to support the Facility and Supported Systems; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition Members, have budgeted for and desire to contractually secure and protect all personnel located at the Facility, the Facility, the Site, and Supported Systems; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition Members desire that County, through the Travis County Sheriff's Office ("TCSO"), provide such services for securing and protecting such personnel, the Facility, the Site, and the Supported Systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, the Parties agree as follows:

 The TCSO, in accordance with Attachment I, Security Costs and Scope of Work, collectively called the "SOW", shall provide certain necessary security and loss prevention services to the Coalition Members to protect personnel, the Facility, the Site, and Supported Systems. The FY03 funding for this activity is an amount not to exceed \$238,000. The SOW will be amended annually to reflect the SOW for the upcoming fiscal year. The SOW will be amended in the same manner that a budget is recommended for the Coalition under the CEC Interlocal.

2) The City, acting as the managing Coalition Member partner authorized to contract for services on behalf of Coalition Members, shall administer and manage physical security and loss prevention services for the Facility and Supported Systems in accordance with Attachment I, SOW.

3) TCSO shall provide monthly invoices to COA, who shall bill the Coalition Members in accordance with the CEC Interlocal, Section 8.E. Funding Transfers to COA. COA. will pay the invoice immediately upon receipt of funds from the Coalition Members.

B. Indirect Personnel Costs - \$1483.00, based on 3.5% of base salary, includes administrative costs of payroll, personnel, fiscal, training and computer support.
