


EXTENDING METER HOURS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

DOWNTOWN MOBILITY

- In 2015 space utilization surveys were conducted for parking in the core downtown, which showed:
 - ✓ Almost 100% of metered spaces were occupied during the day.
 - ✓ In key areas, near activity centers of downtown core, over 85% of spaces were occupied on Wednesday night.
- Best management practices calls for space occupancy to remain under a range from 75-85% of capacity.
 - ✓ Goal is to have 1 to 2 spaces available at all times.



- Extending meter hours will improve mobility by:
 - ✓ Creating incentive for space turnover
 - ✓ Available spaces eases traffic congestion, less circulation
 - ✓ Providing more opportunities for local businesses
 - ✓ Encouraging the use of underutilized off-street parking facilities
- Stakeholder parking surveys conducted between December 2015 and January 2016:
 - ✓ Two most popular suggestions were to install wayfinding elements and to raise meter rates.
 - ✓ Approximately (19) Stakeholder Organizations
 - ✓ DAA sent a letter on January 16th of 2016 requesting implementation of Wednesday evening "extended hours"

Austin Transportation Department (ATD) is proposing to extend meter hours for City-owned, on-street parking spaces in the downtown area.

§ 12-3-5 - TIME LIMITS ON PAID PARKING.

(B) Paid parking time limits for spaces located within the area bounded by Lady Bird Lake, IH-35, 10th Street, and Lamar Boulevard are in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday; 6:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; and 11:01 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, unless otherwise posted.
