## Additional Data Requests and Questions asked by Asian American Quality of Life Commission for Presentation on March 21, 2017

### Calendar Year '16 Health Equity Contracts: April 1, 2016-Dec 31, 2016

- Self-reported race data illustrate 62 Asian unduplicated service provisions under the 2016 Health Equity contracts, representing 1.35% of the 4,594 total number of unduplicated service provisions.

### First 2 quarters of Health Equity Contracts: April 1, 2016-Sept 30, 2016

- Self-reported race data illustrate 40 Asian unduplicated service provisions under the 2016 Health Equity contracts, representing 1.12% of the 3,564 total number of unduplicated service provisions.

### 1<sup>st</sup> quarter FY 2017: SS General Fund Contracts Oct 1, 2016-Dec 31, 2016

- Self-reported race data illustrate 882 Asian unduplicated service provisions under the Social Service contracts in fiscal year 2016, representing 2.2% of the 40,101 total number of unduplicated service provisions

### Fiscal Year 2016: SS General Fund Contracts Oct 1, 2015 – Sept 30, 2016

- Self-reported race data illustrate 2,112 Asian unduplicated service provisions under the Social Service contracts in fiscal year 2016, representing 1.59% of the 132,933 total number of unduplicated service provisions.

**Caveat:** For both the health equity contracts and social service contracts, Asian Americans may be undercounted if they were categorized as: “some other race”, “two or more races”, or “not specified”.

\* During the annual renewal process APH is undergoing for 12-month renewals (4/1/17 – 3/31/18), Council has authorized funding in this year's budget for a 2.3% "cost of doing business" increase to the annual amount of each contract. The 2017-2018 amounts should remain the same for the 4 remaining 12-month extensions, unless Council authorizes different funding amounts each fiscal year.

2. What percentage of Asian Americans are anticipated to be served with the award Council made to Catholic Charities for expanded immigration legal assistance?

**APH Response:** Agencies are not asked to commit to serving a certain number of people by race. All persons that are eligible may be served. APH is following-up with the contractor regarding serving and outreaching to the Asian American community.
