WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for \$452,219 in grant funding from the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority, for the continuation of the Auto Theft Interdiction Project in the Austin Police Department to combat motor vehicle burglary and theft; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles in full; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council approves the application for and acceptance of grant funding from the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority in the amount of \$452,219.
