**Additional Backup Information**

The City of Austin Fire Department (AFD), Travis County Emergency Service District # 4 (ESD 4), and related parties have collaborated on an Interlocal Agreement that will allow AFD to respond to calls for service within ESD 4's jurisdiction. AFD seeks authorization to move forward with final execution of the terms of the Agreement. The Service Agreement will cover the transition of current ESD 4 firefighters into the AFD workforce and consideration of related property and equipment. Training of ESD 4 firefighters will take place in the summer and they will become City of Austin employees on October 1, 2017, when fire service to the area begins. Amendments to the Fire Department budget to accommodate Agreement funding and staffing will be incorporated into the budget adoption process. The initial term of the Agreement will begin when it has been signed by both parties and will end on September 30, 2018. The Agreement will automatically renew annually on October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
