

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING AND READOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF
CHAPTER 9-3 RELATING TO NON-EMERGENCY CURFEWS; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City Council, after review of Austin City Code Chapter 9-3, (*Non-Emergency Curfews*), and having conducted a public hearing as required by Chapter 370 of the Texas Local Government Code, readopts and continues in effect Austin City Code Chapter 9-3 (*Non-Emergency Curfews*).

PART 2. The City Council find that the need to continue and readopt the provisions of Chapter 9-3 (*Non-Emergency Curfews*) constitutes an emergency. Failing to make this ordinance effective on or before June 18, 2017 will result in the automatic expiration of Chapter 9-3 (*Non-Emergency Curfews*). Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect on June 18, 2017 for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety.
