Remove and re-lay brick veneer to install insulation; modifications to windows.

4. HDP-2017-0037 – 1903 W. 30th Street (Old West Austin)

Construction of a principal house and an ADU.

5. C14H-2013-0002 – Commodore Perry Estate, 710 E. 41st Street.

Repair and restore the mansion, add a removable awning; repair and alterations to the surrounding stone wall.
