This action requests City Council to conduct a public hearing to hear public comments on the water, wastewater, and reclaimed rate changes proposed in the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Operating Budget. Council is scheduled to adopt the budget on September 11, 12, and 13, 2017. The City Code in Section 2-5-45 specifically requires a public hearing prior to the City Council approving any changes in electric, water, wastewater, and garbage collection rates.
