Austin-Travis County Food Policy Board

The Austin-Travis County Food Policy Board advises both Austin City Council and the Travis County Commissioners Court about ways to improve the availability of safe, nutritious, and affordable food that is grown locally and sustainably for all residents, particularly those in need.

The Board was officially established with City of Austin <u>Ordinance 20081120-058</u> and the Travis County Commissioners Court approved a similar ordinance soon after; it was seated and began meeting in the spring of 2009.

The purpose of the Austin-Travis County Food Policy Board is to:

- Address health disparities
- Increase local sustainable food production
- End food injustices
- Ensure the community has a voice in policy decisions that support a healthy and equitable food system
