The City entered into an agreement with Austin Outreach and Community Service Center, Inc. in February of 2015 to reduce the disproportionate impact of HIV/AIDS on the African American population in the Austin area through street level outreach, risk reduction education, increased access to HIV testing, and increased referrals to social and medical services. The objective of the project was to increase consistent condom use by African American women and African American Men Who Have Sex with Men.

The initial contract term was January 1, 2015 through December 2015 in the amount of \$57,500. The contract was not renewed due to funding restraints, but the vendor was not properly notified of the contract ending and continued to provide services for an additional seven-month period. The Parties have agreed to payment in the amount of \$27,111 for additional services performed from January 1, 2016 through July 31, 2016. The initial contract amount of \$57,500 and the current contract amount of \$27,111 results in a combined total payment of \$84,611.

Austin Outreach submitted a completed payment request and monthly expenditure report in sufficient detail to confirm the performance of services for the additional seven months, which was reviewed and approved by the City. Council ratification of this contract will allow Austin Outreach to be reimbursed for the services provided during the seven month period from January 1, 2016 through July 31, 2016.
