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**Subject**

Approve negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 6 to the agreement with FOUNDATION COMMUNITIES, INC. for the provision of permanent supportive housing services, adding one twelve-month extension option beginning October 1, 2017 in an amount not to exceed \$108,438, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$622,876.

**Amount and Source of Funding**

Funding in the amount of \$108,438 is contingent on Council approval of the proposed Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Operating Budget for Austin Public Health.

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Prior Council Action:	On September 14, 2016, Council approved Ordinance No. 20160914-001 adopting the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Operating Budget adding a 2.3% cost of living increase on social services agreements, resulting in Amendment No. 5. On September 22, 2016, Council approved Amendment No. 4 to add one twelve-month extension option beginning September 30, 2016, in an extension amount not to exceed \$106,000. On September 27, 2012, Council approved a 24-month agreement beginning on September 27, 2012 with one 24-month extension option.

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**Additional Backup Information**

On March 25, 2010, Council passed Resolution No. 20100325-053 directing the City Manager to give priority to funding permanent supportive housing (PSH) and to develop a comprehensive strategy for the construction and operation of 350 permanent supportive housing units over the next four years.

To that end, the City's Austin Public Health Department conducted a solicitation with a Request for Application for the provision of social services for homeless individuals in permanent supportive housing units resulting in submissions by two applicants, including one by Foundation Communities. On September 27, 2012, Council approved an agreement with Foundation Communities for the provision of permanent supportive housing services to frequent users of the Austin Resource Center for the Homeless and Downtown Austin Community Court beginning September 27, 2012 through September 30, 2014, with one 24-month renewal option. On September 22, 2016, Council approved an additional twelve-month extension option.

On October 2, 2014, Council passed Resolution No. 20141002-043 directing the City Manager to set a community target of 400 additional PSH units to be delivered through coordinated, community-wide efforts in the next four years, and to adopt the updates to the PSH strategy recommended in the August 2014 PSH Evaluation Report.

This twelve-month extension will allow a continuation of the successful provision of PSH services to permanent supportive housing residents.
