Additional Backup Information	

The Anderson Mill Limited District (District) in northwest Austin was created through a Strategic Partnership Agreement (SPA) with the Anderson Mill Municipal Utility District (MUD), which was annexed and dissolved in December 2008. The terms of the current SPA allow the Limited District to own and maintain its parks, pool, and recreational facilities, provide solid waste collection through a private hauler, and enforce deed restrictions for a 10 year period concluding on December 31, 2018.

The Second Amendment to the SPA provides for the renewal of the District's authority at the end of its initial 10 year term and the District's automatic renewal for successive 10 year terms unless the City or the District provides written notice to the other party at least 12 months in advance of the end of the then existing term if the party does not wish to renew the Limited District. All other terms and conditions of the SPA will remain in effect.

Staff recommends approval of this amendment.
