## Recommendation

The Early Childhood Council recommends that City Council continue the current level of funding for the AISD Parent Support Specialists at Title I schools and explore ways of expanding support for parent support specialists in Title I schools in other school districts that serve Austin children.

## **Description of Recommendation to Council**

Current City of Austin funding for the Austin ISD Parent Support Specialist program in the amount of \$1,292,676 is set to expire in December 31, 2017. This is one-time funding that is included in the City of Austin 2016-2017 operating budget. This recommendation seeks to continue current level funding for the program in the City of Austin 2017-2018 operating budget currently under consideration. The recommendation also requests that City Council consider expansion of this program in other Title 1 school districts where Austin children are enrolled.

## Rationale:

Current Parent Support Specialist program staffing would be impacted in over 60 Title 1 schools in Austin if funding expires in December 2017. The Parent Support Specialist program helps navigate the Austin ISD system as well as other resources, forming a bridge between families and community systems. The PSS program follows a dual capacity framework to authentically engage parents and build their capacity and skills (based on their interests) to support and advocate on behalf of their child's education.
