Drainage Charge Overview

- Watershed Protection budget is \$93 million
- 95% comes from drainage charge
- Assessed on utility bills
- Funds programs and projects for our three missions
 - Flooding
 - Erosion
 - Water Quality










Drainage Charge Overview

• Drainage Charge Basics

- Individually calculated for each property
- Calculated same way for all properties
- Based on amount and percent of impervious cover

Drainage Charge Formula

Charge = Base Rate x Impervious
Cover (IC) x Adjustment Factor
(based on percent IC)





Why a Discount?

- Recognize efforts that reduce drainage impact
- Provide a way to reduce drainage bill
- Reduce pollution due to stormwater runoff





Program Development

- August 4, 2016 Council passed ordinance enabling discount program
- March 2, 2017 Rules adopted
- April 2017 August 2017 Program development
- September 6, 2017 Rollout of the program
- Winter 2017 2018 Additional outreach planned

 - Rain Gardens
 - Ponds
 - Green Roofs











- Discount available only for measures that exceed the development requirements.
- Discount may offset up to 50% of impervious cover on the property.
- Applicants can be either a current drainage utility customer or a tenant

• Small Rainwater Harvesting Systems

- Utility Account Number
- Capacity of Tanks
- Photo
- Tanks under 250 gallons each



Rainwater Harvesting








Information Needed To Apply

- Larger Rainwater Harvesting Systems and Other Stormwater Control Measures
 - Site map
 - Amount of impervious cover draining to stormwater control measure
 - Calculations
 - Proof that it exceeds legal requirements for property (typically for ponds)
 - Permit number in some cases





Program Overview - Maintenance

- Maintenance
 - Customers receiving discount must maintain their stormwater control measure.
- Timeline
 - Discount is valid for two years starting on date of approval.
