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**Additional Backup Information**

The Austin Police Department has held meetings with the Juvenile Curfew stakeholders group established by City Council through Resolution No. 20170615-069. The goal of the meetings was to develop recommendations to be presented to City Council on effective non-criminal policies or practices the City of Austin could implement to address behavior that is currently prohibited by the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance. The recommendations of the stakeholders group will be presented to Council at the public hearing. At the public hearing, the Austin Police Department will recommend against continuing and readopting the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance. Unless continued or readopted, the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance will expire on October 1, 2017.
