The Ethics Review Commission may announce it will go into Executive Session, if necessary, pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, to receive advice from legal counsel on matters specifically listed on this agenda (Private Consultation with Attorney-Section 551.071).

The Commission may go into executive session to discuss legal issues related to:

- a. A complaint filed on August 3, 2017, by Abel Ochoa against Idara Bessard, alleging violation of City Code, Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).
- b. Proposed amendments to Article 6 (Anti-lobbying and Procurement) of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).
- c. Failure of Don Pitts to comply with a subpoena issued by the Commission and served on Mr. Pitts on April 26, 2017, ordering him to appear and testify as a witness at a May 10, 2017 final hearing on a complaint filed on February 17, 2017, by Nathan Wiebe against Ashley Buchanan alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), including a possible Commission recommendation regarding prosecution of Mr. Pitts under City Code Section 2-7-99 (Offenses; Penalty) (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).
- d. Possible revisions to City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) relating to the Commission's complaint and hearing procedures and the Commission's Hearing Rules, including provisions relating to evidence submission, findings of violation, and issuance of sanctions (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).

3. NEW BUSINESS

Discussion and possible action regarding the following:

- a. The Commission will review, and may sustain or overturn, the chair's initial determination that the Commission lacks jurisdiction over a complaint filed on August 3, 2017, by Abel Ochoa against Idara Bessard, alleging violation of City Code, Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), and may refer the complaint to the City Auditor, in accordance with City Code Section 2-7-41 (Complaints).
- b. Proposed amendments to Article 6 (Anti-lobbying and Procurement) of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), including a staff briefing and a possible recommendation to Council.
- c. Existing, dissolved, and potential future Commission working group tasks and membership, including the following:
 - 1) The working group tasked with recommending revisions to City Code Section 2-1-24 (Conflicts of Interest and Recusal), City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), the Commission's Hearing Rules, and associated forms;
 - The working group tasked with recommending revisions to City Code Chapter 2-2 (Campaign Finance), City Charter Article III Section 8 (Limits on Campaign Contributions and Expenditures), and associated forms;
 - 3) The working group tasked with recommending revisions to City Code Chapter 4-8 (Regulation of Lobbyists); and
 - 4) The working group tasked with coordinating production of the Commission's City Council election candidate forums as required by City Code Section 2-2-65 (Other Considerations for Campaign Contract).
- d. Failure of Don Pitts to comply with a subpoena issued by the Commission and served on Mr. Pitts on April 26, 2017, ordering him to appear and testify as a witness at a May 10, 2017 final hearing on a complaint filed on February 17, 2017, by Nathan Wiebe against Ashley Buchanan alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), including a possible Commission recommendation regarding prosecution of Mr. Pitts under City Code Section 2-7-99 (Offenses; Penalty).
- e. Possible revisions to City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) relating to the Commission's complaint and hearing procedures and the Commission's Hearing Rules, including provisions relating to evidence submission, findings of violation, and issuance of sanctions.
