SUBJECT: Notice of Proposed Street Closures for New Austin Marathon Route

The 2018 Austin Marathon will celebrate its 27th year running in the capital of Texas on February 18, 2018. Austin's flagship running event annually attracts runners from all 50 states and 20+ countries around the world. In 2017, the Austin Marathon contributed \$34.4 million to the local economy during race weekend. In addition, Austin Gives Miles, the Official Charity Program of the Austin Marathon, raised \$637,000 for 26 non profit organizations in the Central Texas community.

With the 2018 edition of the event, a portion of the Austin Marathon course will change to provide a better participant and spectator experience, allow enhanced traffic flow along the course, and increase synergy with CapMetro transit routes. The Austin Marathon is working closely with the City of Austin Transportation Department and the Capital Metro Transportation Authority throughout the planning of this beneficial course change. **You are receiving this letter because the Austin Marathon course is either changing in your area or is new in your area. Please review this new course and the proposed closures to understand the transportation impact in your area.** Details of the event, the course map, the associated street closures, and an alternate routes map are included below.




