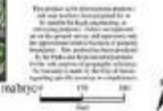
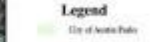
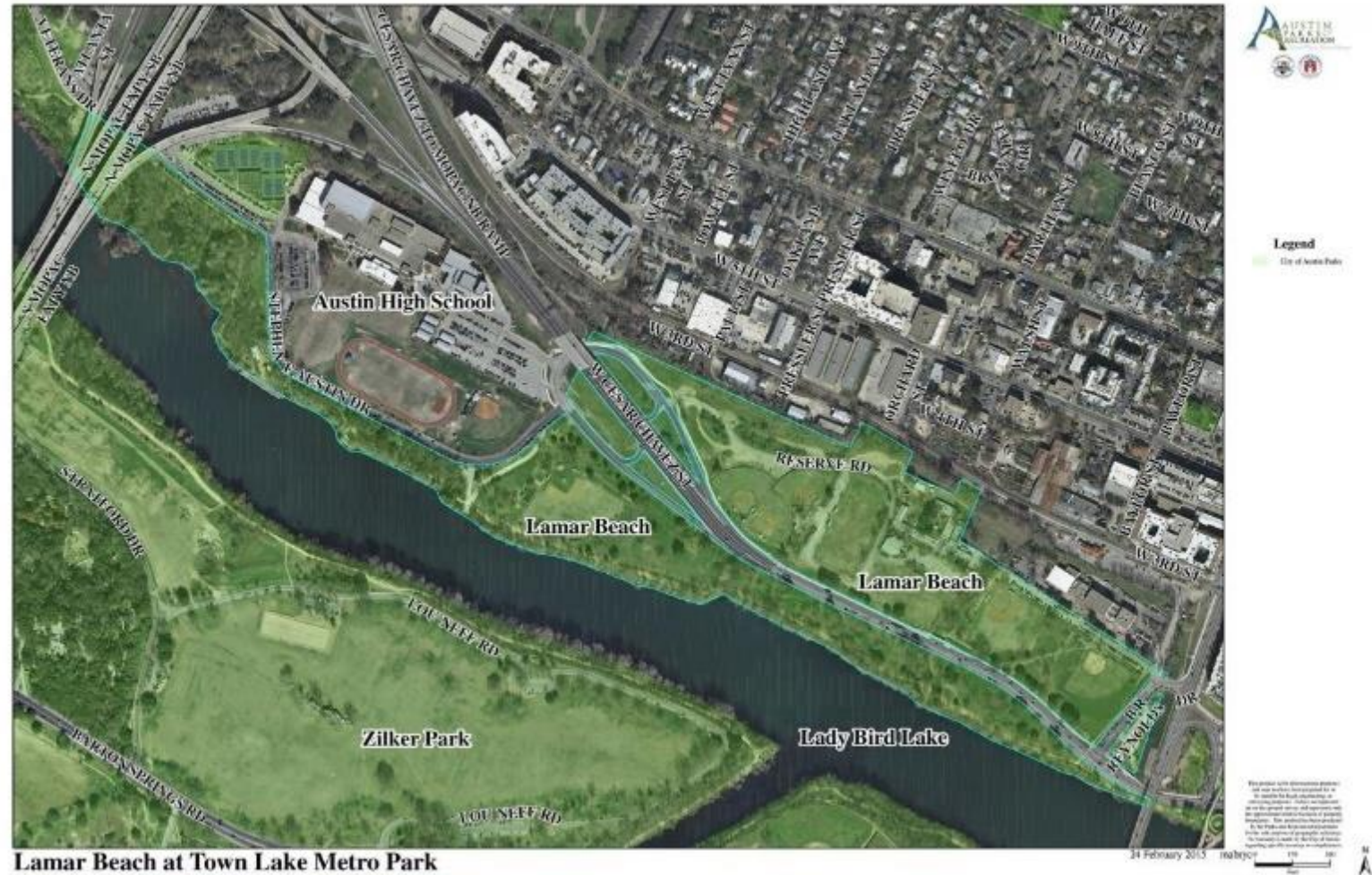

Background

- Lamar Beach consists of 65.4 acres of parkland within Ladybird Lake Metro Park.
- October 2007 – Council voted to keep the Davenport building at TLAC as a permanent adoption center once the shelter on Levander Loop began operation
- Council approved Resolution 20110623-096
- Ch. 26 Hearing to execute a temporary License Agreement – 11/10/11
- Lamar Beach Master Plan Approved– 12/08/16



MASTER PLAN RECOMMENDATIONS – PHASE 1

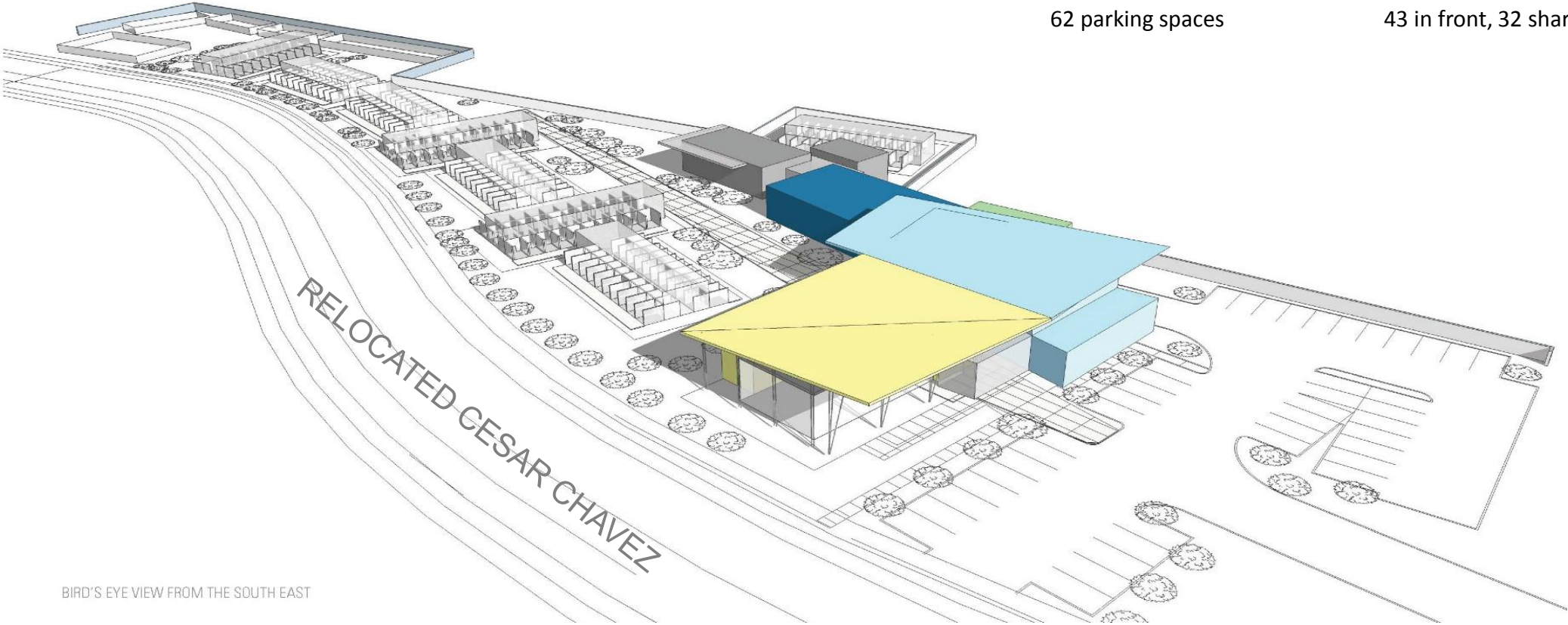
