

## **BRIEF REVIEW**



October 2006 Council Directed the City Manager to work with the Friends of Barton Springs Pool (BSP) and other community groups to develop the BSP Master Plan

The Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) and Watershed Protection Department (WPD) began work on the BSP Master Plan in February 2007

PARD/WPD made Short-Term Recommendations to Council in September 2007

- September 2007 Council approved Action to Fund Short-Term Recommendations
- Resolution recommended creating the "Joint Committee" consisting of Environmental Commission and Parks and Recreation Board Members
- October 2007 Short-Term funding received from Council
- December 2007 First official Joint Commission meeting



# Purpose



- Provide assistance conducting Public Outreach for the BSP Master Plan
- Assist with ensuring projects meet both
  - The environmental goals and objectives
  - The recreational needs of the general public
- Provide advisory joint oversight of implementation of Council approved Short-Term Recommendations
