B. Capital Metro Downtown Station – Briefing and Possible Action

Marcus Guerrero with Capital Metro briefed the BAC on the Capital Metro Downtown Station answered questions.

C. CAMPO 2045 Regional Active Transportation Plan – Discussion and Possible Action

Tom Wald presented draft recommendation language from a BAC subcommittee meeting held earlier in the month. The recommendation language included 28 specific recommendations regarding the Draft Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) 2045 Regional Active Transportation Plan, and a request for CAMPO staff to provide explanations-in-lieu regarding any recommendations CAMPO is unable or unwilling to honor or comply with.
