Per resolution No. 20170817-052 the Aquatic Master Plan Task Force consisting of four Parks

Board Members was established. The purpose of the Task Force was to review the Draft Master Plan, collect additional public input and prepare recommendations regarding the Draft Aquatic Master Plan including policy guidance on how to prioritize investments, including possible pool closures and the building of new aquatic facilities.

Over the past several months, the Task Force has conducted multiple meetings, reviewed the Draft Master Plan, encouraged additional public input, and collected, reviewed, and analyzed information regarding geographic equity, access, environmental and fiscal sustainability, historical and cultural significance, population projections, partnership opportunities and additional funding resources and funding options for incorporation as additional recommendations to the draft Aquatic Master Plan.
