1. CITIZEN COMMUNICATION: GENERAL

2. APPROVAL OF OCTOBER 2 MEETING MINUTES

The October 2, 2017 PAC <u>meeting minutes</u> were unanimously approved (8-0) on Girard Kinney motion and Katie Deolloz second with Heyden Walker absent.

3. ITEMS FROM PAC

A. PAC member introductions + "PAC 101" / Q & A time – Discussion and Possible Action

B. Capital Metro Downtown Station – Briefing and Possible Action

Marcus Guerrero, Project Manager with Capital Metro, briefed the PAC on the Capital Metro Downtown Station and answered questions.

C. Street Design and Public Safety debrief - Discussion and Possible Action

PAC members debriefed the <u>joint briefing</u> on street design and public safety that they received from the Austin Transportation Department and the Austin Fire Department at their October meeting.

Action taken: The following motion was unanimously adopted on Girard Kinney motion, Carly Haithcock second on an 8-0 vote with Heyden Walker absent: *The Pedestrian Advisory Council (PAC) requests that the public hearing of an ordinance adopting the 2015 International Fire Code and related local amendments be postponed at least 30 days after the Austin Fire Department conducts stakeholder meetings to give the PAC and others time to make a recommendation to Council.*

A PAC subcommittee meeting will be held on November 15 to develop more detailed recommendations on this topic for the full PAC's review in December.

D. Technical Subcommittee Draft Austin Street Design Guide Recommendations – Discussion and Possible Action

E. Discussion of subcommittees and potential appointment of new subcommittee chairs – Discussion and Possible Action
