

**RESOLUTION NO. 20171207-100**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing to consider the use of parkland for the dedication of public right of way, known as Nash Hernandez Senior Road, realignment and dedication of the existing public access road into the Rebekah Baines Johnson and Austin Public Health complex, and temporary construction use, through the Edward Rendon Sr. Metro Park at Festival Beach (the "Proposed Use"); and

**WHEREAS**, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described on Exhibit A (the "Affected Land"); and


**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearing to be held on December 7, 2017 was given for three consecutive weeks on November 12, November 19, and November 26, 2017 in a newspaper of general circulation; and

**WHEREAS**, such public hearing was held December 7, 2017, by the City Council to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
