

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Gentrification Study Overview

- Proposed by Councilmember Pool
- Final City Council approval in October 2017
- Completion deadline: August 31, 2018

Gentrification Study Scope

Neighborhood change analysis: Mapping/classification of census tracts in City of Austin (6 types): NEARLY COMPLETE

2) "Neighborhood drilldowns" in two census tracts: SPRING 2018

3) Analysis of anti-gentrification strategies for each neighborhood type in Austin: SPRING AND SUMMER2018

Some details on our work so far

- Analyzed (almost) all Census tracts entirely or partially inside Austin city limits. Assigned neighborhood change typology.
- Excluded "oddball" tracts (UT, West Campus, Camp Mabry, ABIA)
- City tracts compared to average for entire metropolitan area (Travis, Williamson, Hays, Bastrop, and Caldwell Counties)
- Measured departure from average rather than using a hard cutoff
- Most recent Census data is from 2012 to 2016

Vulnerability Analysis

Vulnerability Factors (2012-2016 data)

From L. Bates method:

- Pct. Households in tract < 80% of HUD Median Family Income
- 2) Pct. households without a bachelor's degree or higher
- 3) Pct. people of color
- 4) Pct. households renting



5) Pct. of children in poverty




- Pct of population age 65+

Percent Children in Poverty by Census Tract (2016)






Neighborhood Typology (Draft 1/2/2017)
















