1. Develop an inventory of Green Stormwater Infrastructure practices (EV Commission recommendation);
2. Evaluate Code Next Functional Green and Beneficial Use standards;
3. Include the EV Commission as a review Board and Commission to provide recommendations to Council;
4. Establish a program that encourages increased GSI and leverages existing WPD and AWU programs;
5. Develop a work plan for Integrated Green Infrastructure Plan as set forth in Imagine Austin;

# Summary to Date

- Staff requested an extension of deliverables such that one comprehensive report is delivered by March 31.
- GSI Inventory : Complete
- Function Green and Beneficial Use standards under development and review in anticipation of Code Next Draft 3.
- Water Forward Task Force recommendations due in June 2018; AWU/WPD staff rolling out expanded cistern/rain garden rebate program Spring 2018.
- Integrated GI Plan on schedule for delivery March 2018
