During the FY2018 Budget adoption process, City Council approved Austin Water's 2018 rates and fees. Austin Water conducted a Cost of Service Study which included members of the community known as a Public Involvement Committee (PIC). As a result of this study, Austin Water and the PIC members reached an agreement to reduce the retail water and wastewater rates effective in FY2018.

As part of the recommendations, the following charges will be impacted:

- Retail monthly meter equivalent minimum charge;
- Non-CAP and CAP residential volumetric charges;
- Multifamily monthly minimum charge and volumetric rates;

<ul> <li>Commercial monthly minimum charge and volumetric rates;</li> <li>Large Volume monthly minimum and volumetric rates;</li> <li>Water Revenue Stability Reserve Fund Surcharge (Residential and Wholesale);</li> <li>Waive water drought rates for CAP customers.</li> </ul>
This Council action will amend the Fees, Fines, and Other Changes ordinance approved for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.
