A registrant's employees may perform electrical work that is associated with an electrical permit issued to the registrant.

§ 4-18-23 VEHICLE DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS.

- (A) A registrant shall display its name and license number on each vehicle owned or operated by the business that is used in the conduct of electrical work.
- (B) Each display must comply with Section 1305.166 of the Texas Occupations Code and Section 73.51 in Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code.
- (C) A vehicle described in Subsection (A) may not be used for more than one business.

§ 4-18-24 OFFENSE AND PENALTY.

- (A) A person commits an offense if the person engages in electrical contracting without a registration required by this article.
- (B) An offense under this article is a Class C misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500. A culpable mental state is not required for the commission of an offense under this article, and need not be proved.

§ 4-18-25 SUSPENSION OF REGISTRATION.

- (A) Except as provided in Subsection (B), the building official may suspend a registration if the registrant violates Section 80.39 of Chapter 25-12, Article 4 (*Electrical Code*) three or more times within a 12-month period.
- (B) The building official may suspend a registration if the registrant violates Section 80.39(A)(2), (A)(9), or (A)(15) of Chapter 25-12, Article 4 (*Electrical Code*).
- (C) Except as provided in Subsection (D), the suspension period is six months from the date the registration is suspended.
- (D) If the building official suspends the same registration two or more times, the suspension period is 12 months from the date the registration is suspended.
- (E) If the building official suspends a registration, the registrant may appeal the suspension to the Electrical Board.
- (F) A suspension under this section is not an exclusive remedy for a violation of Chapter 25-12, Article 4 (*Electrical Code*).
