iTeam Background

- The City was awarded a Bloomberg Philanthropies grant for \$1.25 Million for up to 3-years. Funds must be used to create an innovation team and cannot be used for implementation.
- Work on the project began in July, 2017.
- The first phase project is a discovery project on homelessness. Second and third phases are to be determined.

Approach to Homelessness Research

- Focus of research on on people with lived experience of homelessness. Borrowing techniques from software and product development to design for the users.
- Have three research streams: Qualitative (2), Quantitative (1), Service Design and Content Strategy (2). Also, Project Manager (1), Visual Designer Intern (1), Research Interns (2).
- Goals:
 - Goal of the discovery process is to understand the experience of homelessness in Austin to identify solutions that improve the system.
 - Be responsive to City and stakeholder needs:
 - Resolution 20171012-015: APH and Office of Innovation, with other stakeholders, asked to execute a public engagement process including current and former ARCH clients.
 - Assisting with other City projects on the topic including several other resolutions assigned to Austin Public Health, Auditor's Office Reports, City's Strategic Planning process, and Assistant City Manager's workgroups.
 - Provided comment with the Assistant City Manager on ECHO's Action Plan.

What We Have Done

- Started work in September and 4-6 week "research sprints"
 - 1. Lived Experience Interviews and Pop-Up at the ARCH
 - 2. Services at the ARCH and Interviews with Case Managers
 - 3. Outside of Downtown and Interviews with Other Clients and Providers
- Deliverables from research sprints:
 - Over 120 client and case manager interviews
 - Communications Review of ARCH and Agency websites
 - Data Review of City of Austin departments
 - ARCH Service Blueprint
 - Lived Experience Advisory Committee
 - Communications and Transparency:
 - i. Meetings with providers and stakeholders to include feedback
 - ii. Weekly Newsletter
- December-February Synthesis/learning what we have learned

- Organizing interview data to find themes and insights:
 - Service Design and Content Strategy
 - Data Insights
 - Qualitative Research Insights
- Prototyping and testing service design concepts with providers
- Defining potential data projects within the City

Where We Are Now

- Drafting Discovery Report about what we have learned
- ARCH recommendations to APH based on research with people with lived experience of homelessness and related memo to Assistant City Manager.
 - Goals:
 - 1. Create clean, safe, and healthy facility
 - 2. Rightsize the ARCH
 - 3. Make system navigation the main function of the ARCH
 - 4. Mitigate the effects of rightsizing the ARCH on clients and the rest of the system while supporting continuous improvement and iteration.
