John Donisi has reported the historically significant 24th Street Bridge has been damaged by a car. The bridge is listed in the National Register of Historic Places and is an Austin City Landmark. The bridge falls within the boundary of the Pease Park Master Plan.

Can a best approach for restoration, following Secretary of Interior Standards, be identified and developed, then shared with our Shoal Creek stakeholders? The bronze plaques will obviously need to be removed and stored until a full restoration of the damaged section is assessed and restored.
