INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AUSTIN AND THE AUSTIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Program Overview

The Practicum in Health Science program offered at AISD/Akins High School is designed to provide for the development of multi-occupational knowledge and skills related to a wide variety of health career pathways. Students will have hands-on experiences for continued knowledge and skill development by offering volunteer hours at McBeth Recreation Center providing adaptive recreation programming for individuals with disabilities.

What is the Purpose of the Agreement?

This is an interlocal agreement between the City of Austin and the Austin Independent School District in which the City of Austin McBeth Recreation Center provides education/training for students interested in a Health Science Program in form of instruction and supervision of AISD/Akins High School students.

Who Does the Program Serve?

The program will serve the students participating in the AISD/Akins High School participating in the Practicum in Health Science program.

What is the Term of the Agreement?

This agreement is to continue in force from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019 and will automatically renew on the anniversary date for three successive 12-month terms unless parties agree to an earlier termination.
